The undersigned, in compliance with your invitation for bids for the **PAVING** for the Garden Plain High School Gym, for Unified School District 267, Andale, Kansas, having examined the site of the work, and being familiar with all the conditions surrounding the work, hereby propose to furnish all labor, materials and supplies and do all work necessary for the project in accordance with the contract documents at the price stated below. These prices are to cover all expenses incurred in performing the required work under the Contract Documents of which this Proposal is a part.

BASE PROPOSAL:

For all the work described in the specifications and shown on the plans for the **Paving** at the Garden Plain High School Gym for the Unified School District 267, Andale, Kansas. The work shall include but not be limited to the new approach (Northeast corner), concrete paving from the new approach –west to the new gym as shown on C1.5, new drive along the north property line and patchwork required for the existing parking lot (northwest corner of the site, due to installation of a new water line). I or (we) agree to perform all the work and furnish all materials complete for the sum of:

TIME OF COMPLETION: The General Contractor is bidding a completion date, with liquidated damages in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each day thereafter, that the Contract remains incomplete, which sum is agreed upon as the proper measure of liquidate damages which the Owner will sustain per diem by the failure of the undersigned to complete the work at the time stipulated, and this amount is not to be construed as in any sense of penalty. This Contractor will be required to meet the time constraints established by the General Contractor.

This Contractor shall coordinate delivery of material and installation with the General Contractor.

This Contractor shall be responsible for the unloading and storage of materials for this project.

This Contractor shall be responsible for putting any debris generated by this work in the central trash receptacle maintained by the General Contractor.

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Paving - ALTERNATE NUMBER ONE: Paving Area 1 (just west of the new Gym)

This alternate shall consider the additional cost to the Base Bid if the Paving Contractor prepares and paves the Area 1 (as shown on C1.3) with 6" of asphalt paving. The General Contractor will be cutting the area to grade, and the Paving Contractor will be responsible for fly ash stabilization of the 6" of subgrade below the finished paving. The Paving Contractor will then install the Base Course to be used as staging during the construction. At the completion of the project, the Paving Contractor will install the Finish Course. This work shall include painting the parking stripes and (2) accessible parking signs. The concrete curbs shall be included in the Paving Contractors Base Bid. The amount of the Paving Contract Base Bid will be increased/decreased/unchanged by the following amount:

Paving - ALTERNATE NUMBER TWO: Paving Area 2 (just west of the new Gym)

This alternate shall consider the additional cost to the Base Bid if the Paving Contractor prepares and paves the Area 2 (as shown on C1.3) with 6" of asphalt paving. The General Contractor will be cutting the area to grade, and the Paving Contractor will be responsible for fly ash stabilization of the 6" of subgrade below the finished paving. The Paving Contractor will then install the Base Course to be used as staging during the construction. At the completion of the project, the Paving Contractor will install the Finish Course. This work shall include painting the parking stripes. The concrete sidewalk and turned down curbs (similar to detail 6/C1.6) will be provided by the General Contractor. The amount of the Paving Contract Base Bid will be increased/decreased/unchanged by the following amount:

Paving - ALTERNATE NUMBER THREE: Paving Area 3 (just west of the new Gym)

This alternate shall consider the additional cost to the Base Bid if the Paving Contractor prepares and paves the Area 3 (as shown on C1.3) with 6" of asphalt paving. The General Contractor will be cutting the area to grade, and the Paving Contractor will be responsible for fly ash stabilization of the 6" of subgrade below the finished paving. The Paving Contractor will then install the Base Course to be used as staging during the construction. At the completion of the project, the Paving Contractor will install the Finish Course. This work shall include painting the parking stripes. The concrete sidewalk and turned down curbs (similar to detail 6/C1.6) will be provided by the General Contractor. The amount of the Paving Contract Base Bid will be increased/decreased/unchanged by the following amount:

Paving - ALTERNATE NUMBER FOUR: East 24' wide drive lane (just east of the East property line)

This alternate considers the additional cost to the Base Bid if the Paving Contractor prepares and paves the 24' wide drive lane (as shown on C1.3) with 6" of asphalt paving. The Paving Contractor shall include the base preparation as specified. The amount of the Paving Contract Base Bid will be increased/decreased/unchanged by the following amount:

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Paving - ALTERNATE NUMBER FIVE: Replace Existing Approach (just east of the East property line)
This alternate considers the additional cost to the Base Bid if the Paving Contractor tears out the existing approach and culvert pipe, and replaces it with new. The new culvert pipe shall be RCP with tapered ends. The approach shall be constructed per the requirements of the City of Garden Plain and Sedgwick County. This alternate shall include all the earthwork required for the complete and proper construction of this curb approach. The width and radiuses shall match the existing. The amount of the Paving Contract Base Bid will be increased/decreased/unchanged by the following amount:
